(GCommTC) Founding Charter

Preamble

The Global Communications Trust Council (GCommTC) is established as an independent, not-for-profit, non-commercial organisation dedicated to addressing scams, frauds, phishing, impersonation, and identity abuse across telecom and digital messaging ecosystems.

Mission

To serve as a globally trusted advisory body that conducts evidence-based research, develops standards, and advises telecom operators and state authorities on preventing and mitigating communication-based abuse.

Objectives

Research abuse patterns across SMS, Voice, WhatsApp, RCS, and OTT channels.
Develop best-practice frameworks, advisories, and technical playbooks.
Engage with regulators, law enforcement, and operators in a consultative capacity.

Governance

GCommTC shall be governed by a General Body, Governing Council, Advisory Board, and Technical Working Groups.

Ethics & Independence

GCommTC shall remain vendor-agnostic, transparent, and free from conflicts of interest.
